Autism Mate		Lite version free \$149.99 full version	Allows visual prompts that are scene based with built in communication capabilities
Nag Me		.99	App for Reminders and will constantly nag you until you say you are done with it.
Alarmed		Free but has in app purchases for additional features	The awesome reminder + timer app that is alarmingly great! Includes pop-up reminder alerts with robust repeat scheduling, flexible snooze and full customization. And pop-up timers with custom messages, countdown / countup and pause. The Errands app by the same company is pretty good too

Awesome Notes		3.99 Lite version free	Combines to do list with visual supports. You can add pictures and videos, set due dates, and repeating tasks. This app is unique because you can customize pictures and fonts.
SIRI		Free (built in to devices)	Use your voice to send messages, make calls, set reminders, and more
Speak Selection (built in Accessibility)		Free (built into devices)	Read aloud text in apps or on webpages
iBooks		Free (built into to devices) Most books cost	iBooks is a digital book app. You can download computer ibooks creator and make your own books and email to devices.
